Marine Lighting

When rowing before dawn or after sunset, all rowers are required to outfit their boats with certified USCG marine lighting. This means a **Red/Green** light in the bow facing forward and a White light facing aft.

Marine lighting is intended to illuminate your boat and indicate direction, and not project light. As such, white bicycle lights are not advised for use as stern lights because they can temporarily blind rowers approaching from the stern.

Below are recommended brands:

- Navisafe these are the best we've found. LED design so the batteries last a very long time. Incredibly bright and can be clearly seen for over a mile. Suction cup or secure mount designs. Attach Red/Green to the foredeck or bow number holder and suction-cup the stern light facing.

- Aqua Signal suction cup design for both bow and stern work quite well on any deck surface. Can also secure the bow light to the bow number holder.

Hat Lights – useful particularly when visibility within a few feet of the water is not very good. Since your head moves, hat lights help further distinguish rowers against fixed lights on your boat and on the shore.
